- Students will be required to come the morning of the Rodeo early enough to help groom and tack up their horses. The time will vary for each rodeo, so check with the instructor for specific times. Students will also be required to come before the Play Days to help groom and tack up their horses as well. The time to arrive will vary so ask the instructor the week before the rodeo. If your child does not come in time to get their horse ready, the horse will be left behind.
- There will be a rotating schedule of two children to come back to KB Horse Camp after each rodeo and/or play days to help put horses. Example: Sara and Katie one rodeo then Lauren and Rachel the next rodeo, etc.
- Students will be required to wear their sponsor shirts to the rodeos and to wear their sponsor shirts or blue KB Horse Camp T-shirt to the Play Days. You will be responsible for buying the shirts, and I will be responsible for paying to have them embroidered.
- Rodeo and Play Day members who use KB horses will be required to pay a \$400.00 fee each year for the general care and maintenance such as coggins test, health papers, hoof trimming, and teeth floating of their horse(s). This is required for the horse to be entered in competitions. (The fee is \$400.00 regardless of how many of KB's horses you use.) The fee for this is \$200.00 every six months. The payment is due at the beginning of each six month period. (Your first payment is due: _____.)
- If your horse wears shoes, you will be required to pay to have the horse shod every six weeks.
- Lessons for Jr. Rodeo Team and/or Play Day members will be \$30.00 for one, one-hour lesson per week, or \$45.00 for two lessons per week. The \$30.00 fee covers only one hour of lessons per week. The \$45.00 fee will cover two lessons per week and extra hours of the instructor's time at her convenience. If your child only wants to go to a few Play Days, you will pay \$30.00 for one lesson per week or \$45.00 for two lessons and extra hours of the instructor's time at her convenience.
- All fees are due at the beginning of each month for all lessons during that month no matter if your child comes or not. (No matter if you are on vacation, sick, etc.) We will make up their lesson time the following weeks by adding additional time to their next scheduled lesson. There are 52 weeks in the year. The only time you will not be required to pay for lessons is if your child is attending my camp.
- You may bring your child out to ride for a third time on the horse they are using for competition during the week when a Jr. Rodeo is scheduled for that weekend if you have paid the \$45.00 fee for that week. Just call and ask for a convenient time.
- Your child may come out any time to rope the dummy and tie goats if you have paid the \$45.00 fee for that week. This will help your child tremendously.
- There is a \$65.00 fee for each Rodeo and Play Day within an hour and a half drive of KB Horse Camp. Rodeos outside of this perimeter may cost more. Ask the instructor prior to the rodeo what the extra cost will be. The \$65.00 fee covers 17 hours of Kim or Brian's time and assistance, their food, diesel, and use of their horse(s), truck and trailer.
 - If you only need a goat tying horse, the fee will be only \$20.00 which includes use of a goat tying horse and assistance from Kim in goat tying. If you would like any additional assistance throughout the day in the other events, there will be an additional \$15.00 fee. (In other words, the total fee is \$35.00 for use of a goat tying horse, assistance in the goat tying, and assistance in other events throughout the day.)

- If you haul and use your own horses, the fee is only \$25.00 which covers any assistance from Kim or Brian.
- Rodeos and Play Day fees need to be paid for by cash or check. When paying by check, the check should be paid to the instructor by the Monday before the rodeo. When paying with cash, it must be paid prior to leaving the premises.
- If the event of rain, you will be required to pay the fee for the Rodeo or Play Days if the horses are hauled to the destination. If you call and cancel with me prior to the horse being hauled, no fee will be charged.
- If your child qualifies for the SJRA finals, the fee will be \$250 for the three days. In addition to this fee, you will be required to pay the SJRA for the stalls of any horse(s) your child uses at the finals.
- Anyone riding any of my horses will pay half of their winnings to me.
- I will keep any kids on the Rodeo Team any time during the year for \$20.00 per day. You will have to provide their lunch and snacks.
- During the year, we will haul to other events for a lower cost.
- You must sign a Rodeo & Play Day Agreement Form to rodeo on the Rodeo Team or go to the Play Days.
- KB Horse Camp reserves the right to amend the Rodeo and Play Day requirements at any time.
- All decisions made by KB Horse Camp instructors and/or staff are final.
